Mayoral Changes

We extend best wishes to our outgoing Mayor, Reva Bauer. Reva has resigned as Mayor of the Village effective February 2019. Reva has served our community since October 2013. Changes in Reva's employment and place of residence have prompted her resignation from Village Council. We wish Reva the best of luck and thank her for her past commitment serving as Mayor of Munster.

Village Council will be setting a date for a by-election as soon as possible to fill the position of Mayor. If any resident is interested please watch for our call for nominations. Persons eligible for nomination as a candidate for Village Council must:

- be at least 18 years old;
- be a Canadian citizen;
- have resided in the municipality for at least three consecutive months immediately preceding the date nomination paper is submitted; and have resided in Saskatchewan for at least six consecutive months immediately preceding the date nomination paper is submitted.

Administrative Change

Another change in the office has included Jan Sylvestre taking on the role of Administrator. Rose Hauesler will still be seen around the office. Rose's continued presence in the office and guidance will assist in a smooth transition as the new administrator eases into the position.
