In our ongoing asset management processes, the Village assesses water infrastructure. We appreciate residents' feedback in this regard.

We require photos of water lines in your home from the point where it emerges from the cement clearly to the water meter, including the water meter.

# **Paperless Billing**

Get your monthly utility notices and receipts via Email. Contact the Village Office...we'd be happy to "hook you up." Just fill out a consent form and give us your Email address...let's save the village substantial costs of printing, invoice forms, envelopes, and postage.

**Please note:** SaskTel scams have been prevalent in the last six

months. As a result, the Village of Muenster will be sending utility bills via the email address Muenster2794@gmail.com
Please add this to your contact lists to avoid your utility bills ending up in your spam folder.

Residents are responsible for bills on a monthly basis. Failure to receive an emailed municipality utility notice does not release the resident from their responsibility to pay any charges specified on the notice, or any penalties that may be incurred by late payments.

# **Payment Options**

There are a number of utility and tax payments options that we offer:

- Auto Debit (Automated Fund Transfer) – avoid those pesky interest charges
- Internet Banking through any Credit Union or CIBC
- Cash or Cheque by mail, in person, or by the drop-off chute available 24/7 (which we encourage residents to use to avoid late payments).
- Etransfer for Taxes ONLY.

# **Lots for Sale**

The Village of Muenster has affordable residential lots available for sale. Residential lot prices range from \$34,000 to \$46,000 in Phillips Bay.

The Village also has three commercial lots available for sale along Railway Street. One commercial lot is available and adjacent to the West end of the Muenster Coop Gas pumps. Two more commercial lots available are located in the space where the blue REACT bins are currently located. These two lots are directly adjacent to and East of Bunz Electric.

Three commercial lots west of the Village Maintenance Shop are expected to be available for sale soon. The subdivision process is nearing completion.

# Fire Response Coverage

Does your Home Insurance cover costs incurred if the Fire Department has to respond to an incident or fire at your property?

You may want to consider whether you wish to take out insurance to cover the costs of Fire Departments responding to calls.

Residents are charged for Fire Departments' response time (even if there is not a fire). Fire Departments can be required to assist when an ambulance is called to a scene.

The provincial dispatch service determines if assistance is required and will call out the Fire Department and/or RCMP to certain situations where they deem assistance is needed.

Not all Insurance companies cover costs for Fire/Responders' labour on such call outs.

A list of Insurance companies that do have Fire Department call out coverage included in their residential home packages (does not include farms) include the following:

- My Mutual Insurance \$2,000 included
- Wawanesa \$10,000 included
- Red River Mutual \$15,000 included
- Sask Mutual Insurance \$5,000 included
- SGI Canada \$0 Included, you must add it.
