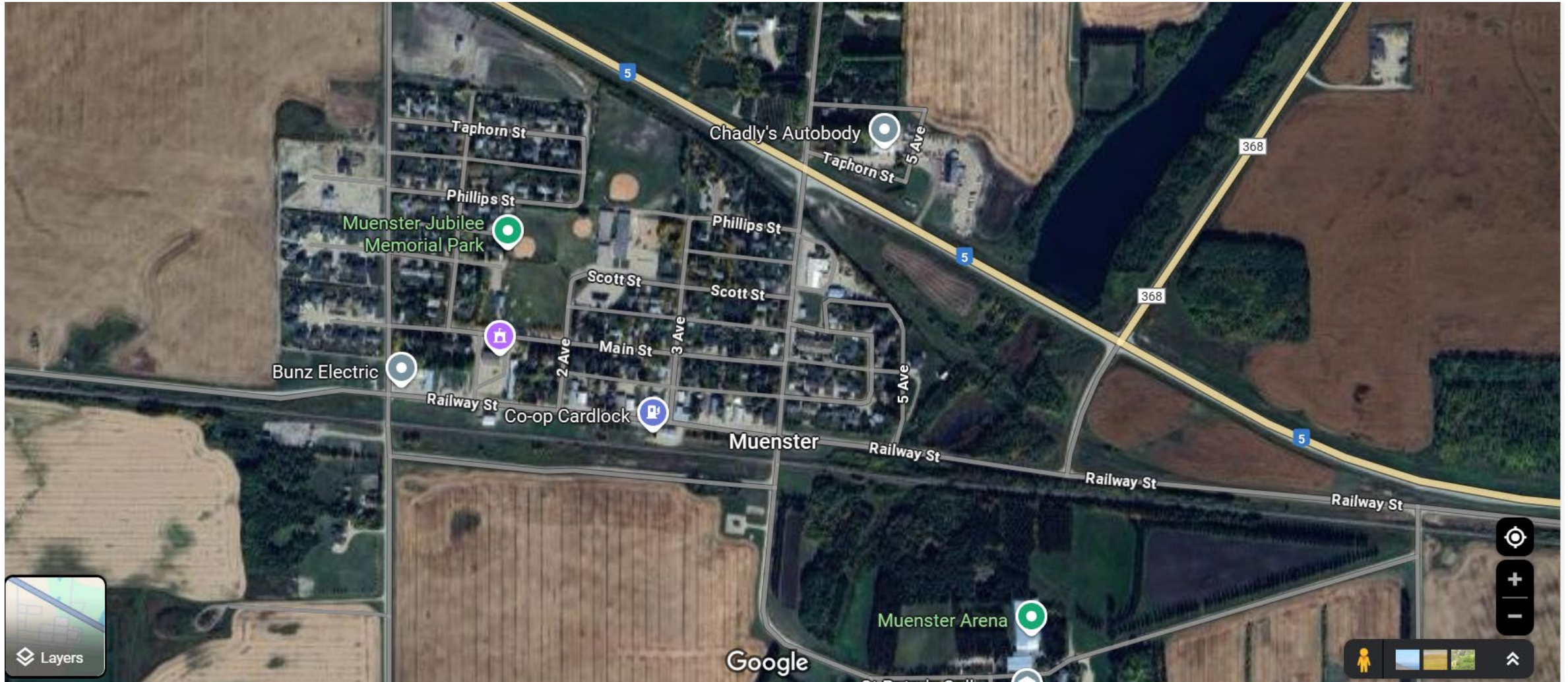

Fun Facts 2025

Out of ~200 Housing Units in Muenster total, 13 Housing Units are Rental Properties. ~ 6.5 % of properties in Muenster are Rental Properties.

**Muenster Village office sends out 203 Utility Bills Monthly.
Approximately 65 of these Monthly Bills are mailed and approximately 138 are emailed.**

Muenster paid \$24,410.00 towards 2025 RCMP services. We appreciate members continuous efforts in serving our community. Police stats April 1-June 30, 2025 = 23 Speeding tickets, 14 other traffic tickets. 47 Calls to RCMP from Muenster during this period.

Muenster Fire Dept. has 11 volunteer members and have been called out 3 times in 2025 so far.

Muenster's water supply comes from the South Saskatchewan River System and is treated in Wakaw then travels by pipe to Muenster and area.

Muenster Village office has not had one stray cat call so far in 2025!

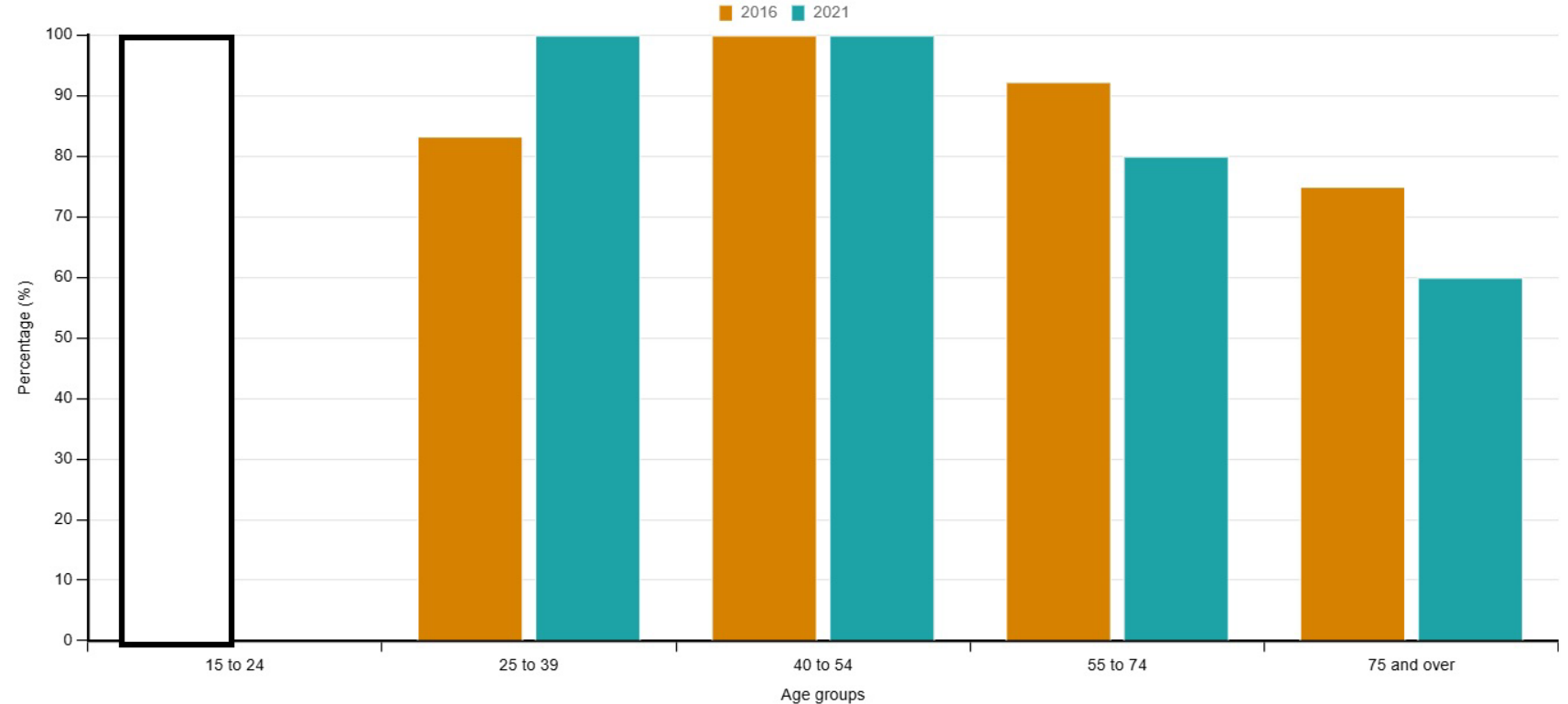

Age of home owning demographics

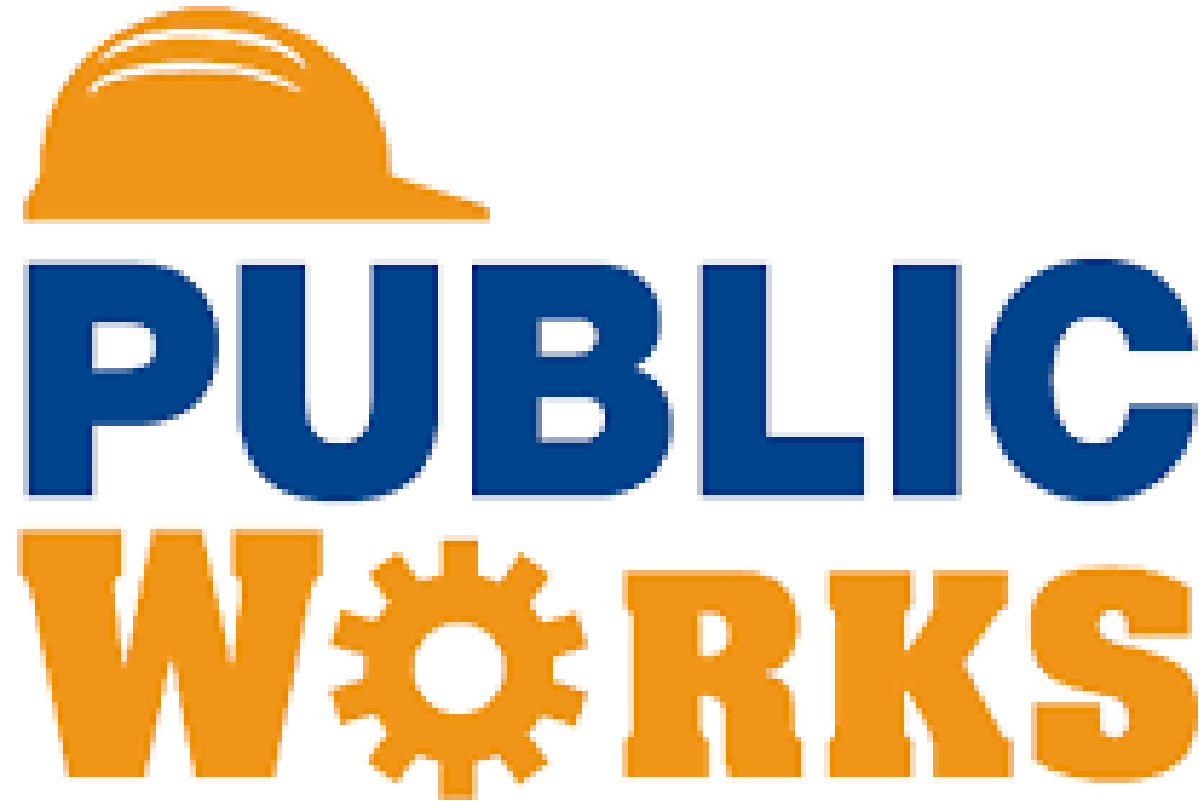

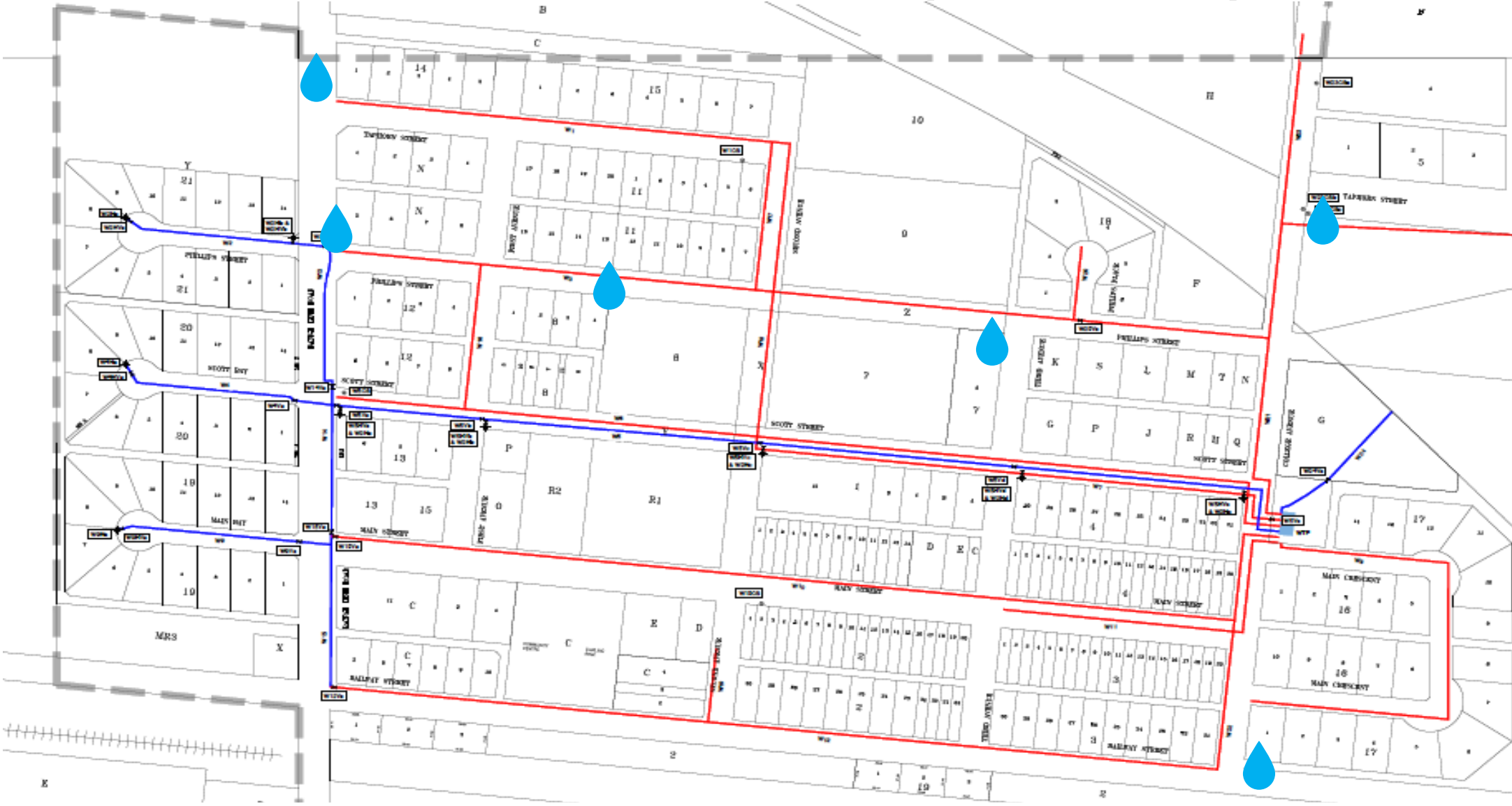
Public Works

- Water table particularly high at Scott St and Range intersection. Drainage has been addressed with ditching and excavation to a ~5' depth of ground in this intersection.
- Dept. of Highways is assessing the condition of culverts adjacent to Hwy 5 underneath College Avenue. Blockages here historically have caused spring thaw backup to travel West and then down Rangeline.
- We are working with the Childcare Center board to ensure drainage paths will continue to exit surface water efficiently.
- React welcomes direct calls to request information about bins and pickup schedules are on Village website.
- Engineers, Catterall and Wright have assisted in developing ARC GIS, an online asset mapping tool to track line locations, infrastructure work history , infras specs , etc. Subscription \$1000 per year.

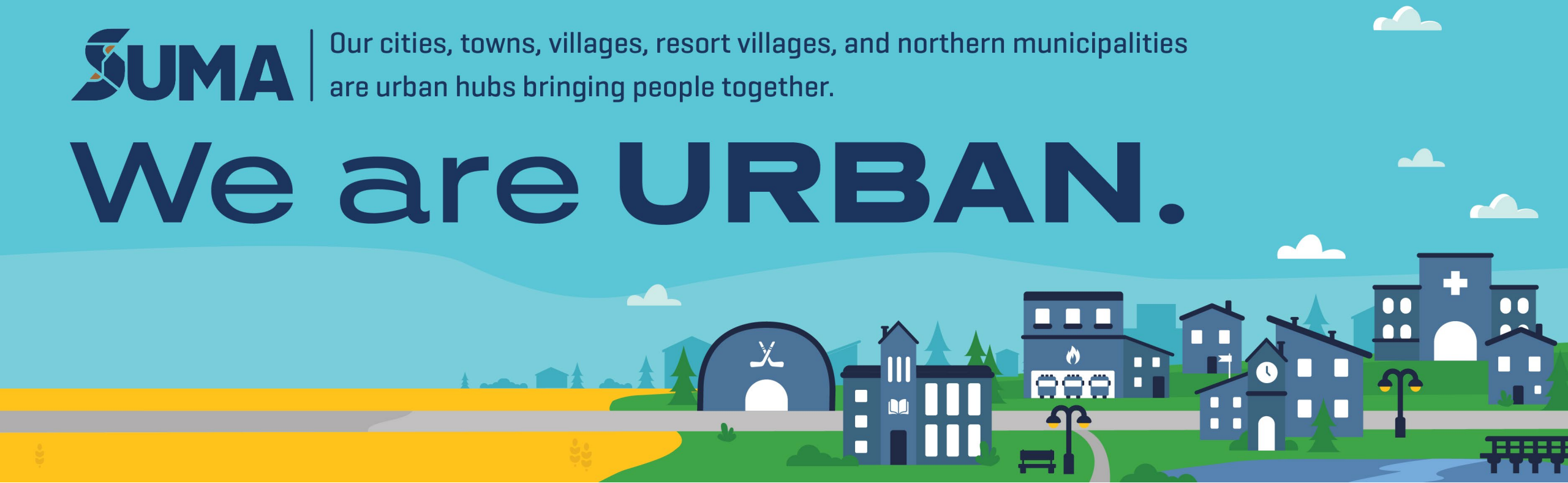

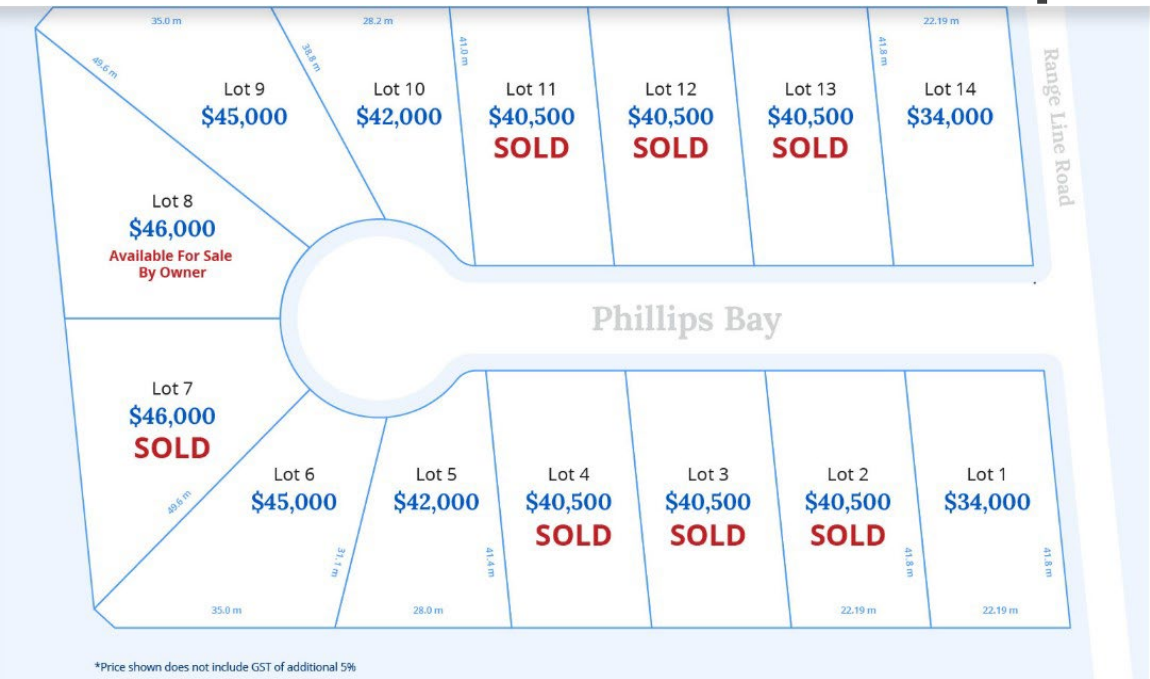

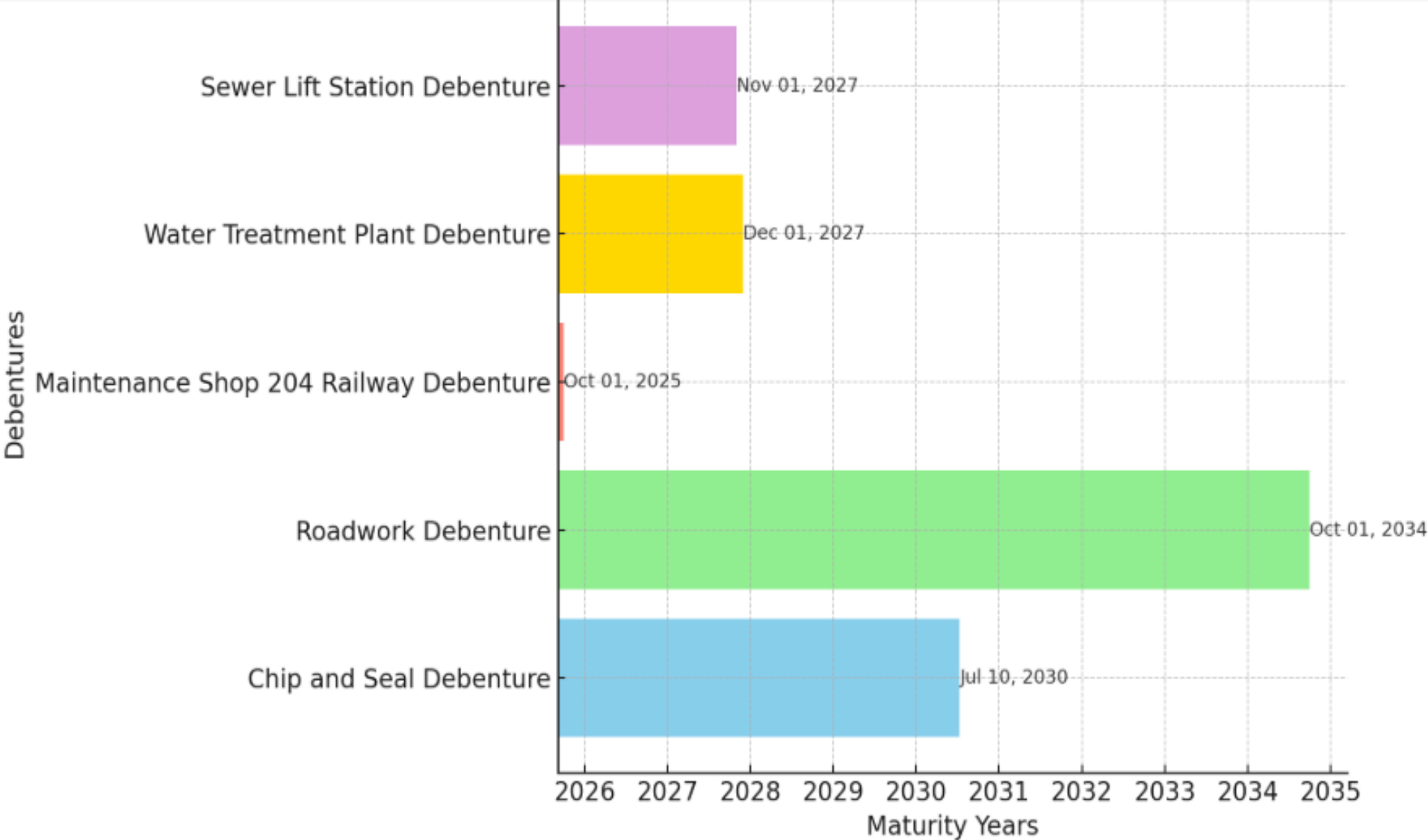

- **The Humboldt and District Fire Protection Assoc**
- Fire Depts serve RM of Bayne, RM of St. Peter, RM of St. Benedict, RM of Wolverine, RM of Humboldt, Village of St. Gregor, Village of Muenster, City of Humboldt.
- Defines Services and Billing
- **Mutual Aid Agreement** renewed January 2025 –"To help when needed and billout as defined"
- Annual Levy ~\$11,000.00
- 911 Dispatch determines who is called out.
- **Homeowner Insurance** –Basic may not cover all fire callout costs. Ex \$1500 for Humboldt to mobilize and get turned around when not needed on scene.
- Bylaw 3/2008

Emergency Services

- **The Humboldt Emergency Planning District**
- Regional effort to respond to states of EMERGENCY.
- **Will hire an EMO Coordinator**
(Emerg Measures Organization Coordinator)
 - Duties include chair local committees,
lead training,
report incidents,
assist with budgets,
liaise with Humb Em Planning Committee, Mutual Aid Area and Sk Public Safety Agency
- Proximity Response Groups within District are establishing emergency response plans.
- Training for Emergency Response to commence 2026

- **Muenster Emergency Management Organization** Bylaw
- Outlines Muenster's responsibility and authority to deal with local emerg.
- **Local Muenster Emerg Planning Committee** is appointed to act/decide during emergencies. (No authority to borrow \$, pass bylaws or enter contracts.)
- Ex RCMP, Fire Chief, Vill Foreman, Vill Administrator, Councillors Fetter / Haeusler.
- Bylaw 9/2025 (replaced Bylaw 2/1997)

Muenster Volunteer Fire Dept.

- Active 11 member unit.
- Fire Tanker
- Incident Response Truck

Local Subcommittee of Council includes RCMP, Fire, Vill Foreman, Vill Admin, Councillors Fetter/Haeusler whose duty is to ensure procedures/plans are in place and individuals are trained for specific roles. Training to come in 2026

Village Office is the designated location for our Emergency Operations Center (EOC)

This Emergency Command Center will serve to host the logistics and coordination of the response team at the scene.

In event of emergency, EOC is staffed by 3 individuals:

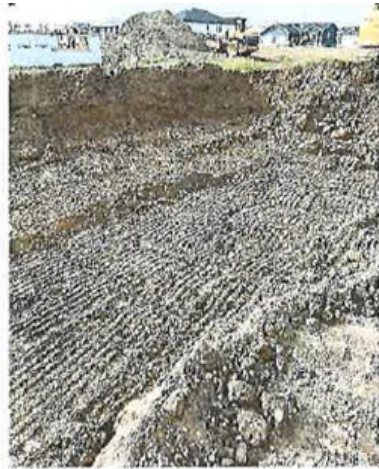
